The City of North Port has several Boards and Committees, please find a list of each below. If you are interested in serving as a member on any of the **City's Boards or Committees** or on a **Sarasota County Advisory Council as a North Port Representative**, please complete the Board - Committee Application. Please be advised that all board members are required to attend a city-sponsored training on sunshine, public records, and ethics law annually pursuant to Chapter 4, Article 1, Section 4-5 (b). Youth members age 14-17 can serve on non-quasi-judicial boards.

Art Advisory Board

Meets 2nd Monday at 6:00 p.m.

Researching a plan to beautify the City government buildings with appropriate artwork.

Audit Committee

Meets as needed.

Selects an auditor to perform the functions as required by Florida Statutes Section 218.391(2).

Beautification and Tree/Scenic Highway Committee

Meets 3rd Wednesday at 1:00 p.m.

Makes recommendations to beautify (U.S. 41) Tamiami Trail corridor and other areas of the City.

Charter Review Advisory Board

Meets quarterly as needed.

Reviews and makes recommendations regarding the City Charter.

Citizens' Tax Oversight Committee

Meets not less than once each year.

Reviews the expenditures from the 1% Local Government Infrastructure Sales Tax.

Community Economic Development Advisory Board

Meets 1st Wednesday at 2:00 p.m.

Meets to advise the Commission on business and economic development and issues of importance to the North Port business community and citizens.

Environmental Advisory Board

Meets 1st Monday at 6:00 p.m.

Makes recommendations to protect, conserve, enhance the City's natural and environmental resources, wildlife habitat, flora and fauna.

Historical & Cultural Advisory Board

Meets 2nd Thursday at 6:00 p.m.

Makes recommendations on ways to protect, conserve, enhance, and raise public awareness of the City's cultural and historic resources.

Joint Management Advisory Board

Meets as directed, at least once annually.

The composition of this Board is unique. See City Clerk for specific qualifications.

Municipal Firefighters Pension

Meets quarterly. Quasi- Judicial.

Determines eligibility, participation, rules and procedures, and performs actuarial studies and valuations of the fund. Requirement to file a Financial Disclosure Form annually with the Sarasota County Supervisor of Elections.

Municipal Police Officers Pension

Meets quarterly. Quasi- Judicial.

Determines eligibility, participation, rules and procedures, and performs actuarial studies and valuations of the fund. Requirement to file a Financial Disclosure Form annually with the Sarasota County Supervisor of Elections.

North Port Youth Council

Meeting times to be determined

To provide a youth perspective on issues that affect the City and provide youth opportunity to be active and make a difference. In their community.

Parks & Recreation Advisory Board

Meets 3rd Thursday at 6:30 p.m.

Makes recommendations on issues related to parks and recreation.

Planning & Zoning Advisory Board

Meets 1st & 3rd Thursday at 9:00 a.m. Quasi- Judicial.

Reviews, makes recommendations on land use actions and the City's Comprehensive Plan. Requirement to file a Financial Disclosure Form annually with the Sarasota County Supervisor of Elections.

Public Utility Advisory Board

Meets 2nd Thursday at 9:30 a.m.

Reviews and makes recommendations on City water/sewer utility issues.

Zoning Board of Appeals

Meets 2nd Friday at 9:00 a.m. as needed. Quasi- Judicial.

Considers appeals on interpretation and administration of zoning regulations and variances. Requirement to file a Financial Disclosure Form annually with the Sarasota County Supervisor of Elections.
